POSITION DESCRIPTION:

Mission Training International (MTI) is seeking a Director for our Debriefing And Renewal (DAR) program.

MTI's vision is for cross-cultural messengers of the gospel of Jesus Christ to experience effectiveness, endurance and personal vitality. We sense that God's specific mission for us is to serve sending agencies by developing and equipping their cross-cultural workers. DAR is one of our key services that fulfills our calling.

The DAR program is designed as a community experience in a preventatively therapeutic milieu where cross-cultural messengers of the gospel of Jesus Christ can safely unpack the paradoxes of their life overseas while on home assignment.

The DAR Director is entrusted with leading the DAR program and staff while in session, constantly improving the community experience towards greater vision fulfillment, and developing the unified effectiveness of the DAR team.

- Coordinating the DAR community experience for messengers of the gospel leading to effectiveness, endurance and personal vitality in their cross-cultural callings
- Empowering the DAR team to experience loving unity as they sacrificially serve gospel messengers
- Developing high-trust relationships with the other teams at MTI – especially other team leaders
- Assisting in other MTI endeavors that align with their personal gifts and leadership skills – e.g. training and supervising Compass program coaches. Specific responsibility TBD
