



JOB OPENING – ADULT DEBRIEFER for DAR

POSITION DESCRIPTION:

Mission Training Int'l (MTI) is seeking Adult Debriefers for our Debriefing And Renewal (DAR) program.

MTI's vision is for cross-cultural messengers of the gospel of Jesus Christ to experience effectiveness, endurance and personal vitality. We sense that God's specific mission for us is to serve sending agencies by developing and equipping their cross-cultural workers. DAR is one of our key services that fulfills our calling.

The DAR program is designed as a community experience in a preventatively therapeutic milieu where cross-cultural messengers of the gospel of Jesus Christ can safely unpack the paradoxes of their life overseas while on home assignment. The community experience of DAR is in high demand – with up to 600 adults and children served each year from more than 50 agencies with many more on the waiting list. More importantly, the DAR program is praised by those who attend as leading to deeper levels of personal vitality and a renewed vision for effectiveness and endurance.

We have 7 DAR program dates for 2020 needing a total of 6 Adult Debriefers including 3 male and 3 female per program. We currently have openings for fulltime Adult Debriefers and adjunct only Adult Debriefers. Start Dates for 2020 are; 2/10, 3/30, 5/11, 7/6, 8/24, 10/12, 11/30. Adult Debriefers Training Week: TBD. For each program, the DAR Adult Debriefers begin on Monday morning and conclude on Saturday afternoon. We are seeking a commitment to 5 of the 7 weeks plus one week for training.

A DAR Adult Debriefers is entrusted with joining another adult debriefer in facilitating a group of 8-12 adults as they are guided through both open-ended and focused reflections on one's life overseas.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Providing hospitable, understanding, safe, caring relationships for others to process the impact of cross-cultural living on their souls
- Creating emotional space and a place for a group of adults to unpack their recent life stories in hopes for increased future effectiveness, endurance and personal vitality in their cross-cultural callings
- Growing in active listening and group processing skills
- Contributing to the larger DAR team's loving unity as they sacrificially serve cross-cultural messengers
- *Full-time position at MTI– responsibilities will include coaching, and perhaps facilitating modules in our pre-field program called Compass. Adjunct only- responsibilities will not including pre-field coaching responsibilities*

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Calling, passion and experience in providing a hospitable, safe place for cross-cultural messengers of the gospel of Jesus Christ to unpack the stories of their recent overseas assignment
- Training, supervised experience, and proven skills in active listening and process groups
- Mission field experience or more than 15 years working in member care
- A commitment to 5 of the 7 weeks, plus one week for training.

COMPENSATION:

If full time position sought: It is a support-based position with benefits

If adjunct position sought: Those from out of town will have their airfare, transit, meals & lodging covered. Those living in Colorado will receive an honorarium
