Overview

The Director for our Debriefing and Renewal (DAR) program is entrusted with stewarding the participants' experience where the realities of their past and their impact are expressed and understood for the purpose of release, renewal, and moving forward. The DAR program is designed as a community experience where the participants meet in small groups, by gender groups, and for individual debriefing. The DAR Director's role is also focused on shepherding the DAR team and continuing to improve the curriculum. The goal of this position is that our between-field efforts increase the effectiveness, endurance, and personal vitality of the missionaries we serve.

Responsibilities

- Coordinates the DAR community experience for program participants leading to effectiveness, endurance, and personal vitality in their cross-cultural callings.
- Leads the DAR adult team and oversees the Kids Program Director.
- Serves as an adult debriefer several times a year.
- Serves on MTI's Leadership Team.

Qualifications

- Has a relationship with Jesus Christ and who is growing in faith, character, and the knowledge of God.
- Calling, passion and experience in providing a hospitable, safe place for missionaries to unpack the stories of their recent overseas assignment.
- 5+ years of Mission field experience, Master's in counseling preferred.
- History and passion for debriefing others in active listening and process groups preferred.
